INDEX OF THE EUROPEAN SPECIALISED PERIODICAL LITERATURE
IN THE YEAR 1909

As in the previous year, we are giving a listing of articles relating to special fields of collection that have appeared in the European specialised press. We explained in our March 1909 issue why we thought the publication of such a listing was advisable and practicable, and it is not necessary to go into all that again. It is obvious how useful such a listing must be to specialist collectors and its advantages need not be discussed any further.

Only the European specialised periodical literature is covered for the year 1909 but we have made provision for the coverage of non-European periodicals as well during the current year, so as to produce a world listing.

The index is again given alphabetically in the sequence of the last great Kohl Catalogue.

The names of the periodicals are abbreviated as shown below. The numerals after the initials show the pages of the relevant periodicals covered for the year 1909. Spaced-out numerals indicate that the article, etc., concerned has been reprinted from another periodical. It often happens with English periodicals that the volume does not coincide with the calendar year, so that there can be two volume numbers for one calendar year. In these cases the initial letters for the periodical are followed by a Roman numeral referring to the volume concerned. One periodical has a fresh sequence of page numbers for each individual issue: in this case, Nr. 1/10, for example, means Issue 1, p.10.
